
## **Scoring System User Guide**

- Position yourself seated at the end of the boccia court near the TV screen.
- Open the Boccia Scoreboard app on the iPad and input the match details according to the scoresheet (match type, classification and player names). Set up the two-minute warm-up.
- Indicate to the referee that you are ready and watch for the referees signal. You will start the timing count down when the referee indicates to you which colour is to play.
- Pause the timing when a coloured ball either; comes to a stop on court, crosses/touches the side or ends lines, or is retracted by the referee.
- You will start and pause the timing throughout the match as the referee signals and the balls are played.
- Verbally announce clearly and loudly when the remaining time is "1 minute", "30 seconds", "10 seconds", "Time" when the time is expired.
- Penalties should be added as required through the match.
  Penalty balls awarded will automatically apply at the end of each end.
- At the completion of each end, first complete the paper scoresheet with: time remaining, score, substitutions, time-outs and penalties.
- On the iPad, click the 'next' arrow in bottom right hand corner to visit the next screen and input the score.
- Follow the instructions on screen to the next ends and eventually the end of the match.
- On completion of the match complete the paper scoresheet with final scores, winning teams and your signature before handing to referee.
