

Why do we need Good Governance?

- Well-run club
- Compliance
 - Financial procedures in place with accountability
 - Wellbeing and Protection
 - Policies and procedures in place for when things go wrong
 - Breaches of the code of conduct
- Clear roles and responsibilities (not the same person doing everything)
- Appropriately qualified coaches delivering sessions
- Clarity of decision-making
 - Collective decision making
- A committee-wide contribution to the club (not one person)
- Succession planning
- Access to funding & sponsorship (credibility)
