

#### **Course Dates – 2025/2026**

- Level 1 Award in Coaching Boccia: Starting Jan 2026 (practical likely to be Perth)
  - £300 per person (80% funding available) + travel costs
- Level 2 Award in Coaching Boccia: Starting Feb 2026 (practical in North England).
  - £500 per person (80% funding available) + travel/accommodation/sustenance costs
- CAP: Possibility of applications opening late 2026.
  - Fully funded
- Level 1 Award in Officiating Boccia:
  - Fully funded
  - Elgin 31/08/2025
  - Perth May 2026
